The following are procedures recommended for using the slit fixture. Deviations from these procedures may result in injury and / or excess waste. Users should also review their company safety rules and applicable safety laws and regulations.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Hole sizes can be laser marked for identification.

To install a new blade:

- 1. Cut-resistant gloves should be worn
- 2. Loosen the two blade retaining screws from the side of the fixture.
- 3. Remove blade from the fixture and discard in a sharps container.
- 4. Lightly tighten the two blade retaining screws to secure the new blade in the fixture.

To Slit part:

- 1. Insert the FluorPEELZ™ tube into the smallest hole that it will fit freely.
- 2. Push the FluoroPEELZTM into the blade until it hits the back of the razor blade and stops.
- 3. Remove the slit FluoroPEELZ™ from the fixture.

To Peel (Post-Recovery):

- 1. Firmly grasp one side of the slit FluoroPEELZ™ in each hand.
- 2. Pull each half of the FluoroPEELZ™ away from each other in a manner that is perpendicular to the catheter; pull steadily with an even motion removing equal amounts of FluoroPEELZ™ in each hand.
- 3. Stop and re-grasp FluoroPEEL Z^{TM} nearer to the catheter as needed to maintain even and steady removal.
